#### **Students Behavior Expectations:**

- Respect other campers, staff, and animals
- Respect M&M Ranch Clean up after yourself & take care with the property and animals.
- Participate in all activities

<u>Check In:</u> Sunday between 4:30-6:00 pm (We will email times your camper will be assigned for drop off)

Students will <u>need to have had dinner</u> before arrival because only snacks will be provided that evening.

<u>Check Out Friday:</u> We will send email instructions for pick up times. (We end close to 12-12:30 PM)

Friday Schedule: More details and time to be announced. We will send email out.

### Your registration is not complete until receive all forms & complete payment:

All required forms and payments need to be made before camp. The **Camp Agreement** page must also be received via email or regular mail prior to the start of your camp session.

### **Cancellation Policy:**

If for some reason, (e.g. emergency), you need to cancel your child's camp the following conditions apply:

• The deposit is non-refundable. If you have an emergency and need to cancel your child's camp session, please email us. We do not offer refunds for any reason.

#### **Payment Policy:**

- Any remaining balance for Overnight Camp is due May 14, 2023. To make final payment go to our Contact Page (FAQ).
- If you have a balance due after the posted deadline the late fee of \$125 for Overnight camps will be applied. To make final payment go to our Contact Page (FAQ).

## Communication during their stay at the Ranch

We have found that campers that do not receive packages could have a negative effect on the camp community. For this main reason, we have a no package policy. Please *do not* send any notes by mail.

We do allow you to send your daughter one email by Thursday, while she is at camp. We will print it and give it to your daughter. Please note that they are unable to respond via email. We ask parents/guardians to limit their emails to one, and to please not send photos or e-cards. Send camper emails to: camp@mmhorseranch.com with the camper's first and last name in the "subject line".

<u>Do Not Bring to Ranch:</u> <u>cell phones, electronics</u>, candy, gum, their personal money, expensive jewelry, costly cameras, expensive clothing. The camp is not responsible for items lost, left or damaged. We recommend that campers leave all valuables at home as they are not needed at camp.

Students are <u>not allowed to have electronics with Wi-Fi or network</u> capability, as they create distractions as well as interfere with the development of communication skills. Older iPods and MP3 music players will be permitted for campers to listen to music. We do allow campers to listen to personal music at rest hour and bedtime (e.g., only in the bunkhouse).

(If a student must bring a cell phone, please inform us & we will hold it for her, and student will receive it after camp is over.)
