To ge	et most for students and their horse we strongly recommend:
	Exam by vet for lameness exam (check hock, stifle, back for example), teeth have been
	checked prior to clinic if longer than 8-10 months. We want to be sure before we ask our horses
	to work that pain will not be factor.
	Horses in good condition have been ridden on a regular basis prior to coming to clinic-camp.
	Saddle & saddle size that fit correctly for rider & horse.
Chec	k list of tack & supplies needed for clinic:
	2 Different types of bits: 1) a snaffle & 2) little heavier like a Jr. Cow Bit. Bits should have a
	break in the middle. (contact us if you're unsure what your horse needs)
	Reins that adjust. (Braided ones are ones easily adjusted) – optional to bring Split reins.
	One set Reins that can be removed from the bit easily (not permanently attached to bridle)
	Quality saddle pad that will protect horses back
	Rope Halter only—please use rope halter with lead ropes have a snap for easy removal.
	Fly spray, hoof pick, brushes, grooming materials etc. May Want to Label Your Stuff
	Splint boots, or polo wraps protect legs, and bell boots.
	 Container to keep grooming supplies, boots items in.
	Lunge long lead rope, lunge stick, dressage stick.
	All other equipment's needed for riding or caring for your horse.
