



## Helpful Information when Arriving



- When you arrive please follow the signs to the designated parking area. If you have a lot of stuff that needs to be unloaded, let us know and we will drive over to where you are & help you get your stuff. If someone is dropping their child off and not staying, please let one of our staff know so we can help them get their stuff.
- Please have girls dressed and ready for the horse activity on arrival. There will be a place for them put the stuff on arrival, we will have the girls get settled in bunkhouse after the horse activity.
- We ask that the girls not go into the bunkhouse until instructed, if the adults want to go in and get settle beforehand that is fine. (Reminder, keep door close and take your shoes off setting them on the racks)

## M&M Ranch Policy (Reminders)



- Listen to ranch the instructors and follow directions.
- Do not go near horses without an instructor or permission from an instructor.
- Wear shoes at all time outside.
- No food or snacks in the bunkhouse. (*During movie popcorn is allowed in living area only not on beds*)
- Please recycle (cans, bottles, only.) In the blue recycle bin.
- Please clean up after yourself, throw trash away immediately.
- No shoes in the bunkhouse at all. *Indoor slippers/sandals are fine*
- Keep doors closed in bunkhouse, and the entry room to bunkhouse too. (*This help keep bugs out*)
- Always use a buddy system.
- Restroom (nothing in toilet accepts toilet paper). During outdoor activities please go to back of barn and enter in restroom and not through bunkhouse.
- Please be respectful of each other, animals & property of M&M Ranch
- When it's time to sleep, please stay in your bunk. (If you need anything please ask an adult)

**Do Not Bring to Camp:** cell phones, electronics, candy, gum, personal money, expensive jewelry, costly cameras, expensive clothing. The camp is not responsible for items lost, left or damaged. We recommend that campers leave all valuables at home as they are not needed at camp.
